REMITIDO.

Señores redactores del *Noticioso*.—Las groseras injurias y las atroces calumnias que contra el benemérito juez segundo de primera instancia don Jacobo Ulloa se ha atrevido á estampar don Manuel Cantillo en un remitido al número 109 de ese acreditado periódico, han indignado á cuantos abrigan sentimientos liberales y conocen los antecedentes del ofendido y del ofensor. El entrar en un analisis ó cotejo de éstos antecedentes fuera deprimir al señor Ulloa, quien, de ser comparado, debiera serlo con persona que significara algo en la sociedad, que fuera ó pudiera ser verdadero punto de comparación; y en tal categoría no se halla por cierto el autor del libelo infamatorio que nos ocupa. El señor Ulloa degradaría su autoridad bajándose á contestar á viles imposturas fraguadas por el mismo á quien ha dispensado indulgencia, tal vez excesiva, por la sola consideracion de ser Guardia-nacional. Su conducta en la sumaria que á instancia de parte se instruye contra don Manuel Cantillo sobre falsedad de un pagaré, está consignada en la sumaria misma, y de ella responderá gustoso el señor Ulloa en su día al tribunal superior del territorio, que acaso extrañará se haya tenido con Cantillo una lenidad incompatible no pocas veces con la averiguacion de los crímenes. Nosotros, hasta ahora solo podemos asegurar el pronunciamiento de la opinion pública

contra el autor del pagaré; prescindimos de los ulteriores resultados de la causa, limitándonos á vindicar al señor Ulloa del rastrero é indigno ataque que á su no desmentida reputacion hace una persona mal intencionada, sin concepto alguno público, y cuyo language en el remitido al número 109 prueba no solo el encono y la alevosia, sino el odio nada disfrazado contra las actuales instituciones. El señor Ulloa tiene acreditado en Jerez *que no se corrompe ni doblega por el oro ni por el prestigio*. Inflexible en administrar rectamente la justicia, activo y celoso en el despacho de los negocios, instruido en la jurisprudencia nacional y pública, acreditado patriota, y comprometido como el que mas en sostener la causa de la libertad, se ha captado la estimacion y el respeto de este vecindario, á quien consta su patriotismo por servicios recientes y positivos que tiene prestados al legítimo gobierno, aprehendiendo al famoso cabecilla Morales, sofocando la vasta conspiracion á cuyo frente estaba aquel, mandando en Bejar el cuerpo de la Guardia-Nacional de caballería, desempeñando en Avila la comandancia militar en críticas circunstancias por honorífica y especial comision de la superioridad, y persiguiendo á los facciosos por do quiera que ha estado, y los ha batido con peligro de su existencia y con costosos sacrificios. A un patriota semejante es á quien se ha calumniado en los términos mas indecorosos y atroces. Sirva pues de confusion al

calumniador el elogio y la defensa que franca y desinteresadamente hacemos del señor Ulloa, prometiendo despreciar cuanto de nuevo quiera decir en su contra el mal intencionado articulista; y suplicando á ustedes se sirvan publicar esta manifestacion de nuestros sentimientos y de nuestra simpatia con un juez recto, ilustrado y decidido.
